A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF LEXINGTON, MINNESOTA, AFFIRMING

WHEREAS, in October 2016, the sewer infrastructure at 3872 Oak Lane in Lexington failed, and that failure caused downstream silt buildup in the sewer system that constituted an emergency;

WHEREAS, the City expended resources and employed contractors to repair that failure and assessed those costs against the property at 3872 Oak Lane. The City assessed \$21,296.32 against the property for those repair costs; and

WHEREAS, the property owners instituted an insurance claim to pay for the assessed repair costs. In order to resolve that claim they and their insurer seek assurances that they have made full and final payment of the repair costs from the October 2016 sewer failure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, MINNESOTA.

The City's assessment in the amount of \$21,296.32 against 3872 Oak Lane is full and final payment for the City's costs stemming from the sewer failure occurring in October 2016.
