#### Purposes Allowed for Open Burning

- Elimination of fire or health hazard that cannot be abated by other practical means.
- Ground thawing for utility repair and construction.
- Disposal of vegetative matter for managing forest, prairie or wildlife habitat, and in the development and maintenance of land and rights-of-way where chipping, composting, land spreading or other alternative methods are not practical.
- Disposal of diseased trees generated on site, diseased or infected nursery stock, diseased bee hives.
- Disposal of unpainted, untreated, non-glued lumber and wood shakes generated from construction, where recycling, reuse, removal or other alternative disposal methods are not practical.
- Fire Training permits can only be issued by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA).

**Fires may not be allowed to smolder with no flame present**

**PROHIBITED MATERIALS ARE:** oils, rubber, plastic, tires, and chemically treated materials, such as; railroad ties, treated lumber, composite shingles, tar paper, insulation, composition board, sheet rock, wiring, paint, hazardous and industrial solid waste.
