Local Decision 2020

A lot of election programming was produced in September. Because of the COVID19 virus, and the confined space of the studio, having all individuals running for a particular office, onstage, at one time, was not a safe option. As such, a decision was made to produce only one-on-one "Meet the Candidate" interviews hosted by NMTV News Producer, Rusty Ray. Each candidate for office was given up to 15 minutes to answer questions and share their vision for their community. Candidates for Mayoral, City Council, County Board, School Boards, and State House and Senate offices were scheduled. In




total, Rusty and Danika recorded 15 shows in September. School Board and County Commissioner interviews are scheduled for the first week in October. In addition to the "Meet the Candidate" forums, Special Events Coordinator, T.J. Tronson, worked with the League of Women Voters and the Ham Lake Chamber of Commerce to record their candidate debates. In total T.J. recorded 7 debates.

Mary Ann Young Center Concert

Special Events Coordinator, T.J. Tronson, worked with City of Blaine staff to provide a live feed of a concert for seniors at the Mary Ann Young Center. Video Engineer, Matt Waldron, and Municipal Producer, Trevor Scholl, worked with T.J. to make sure the video and audio would work via the Zoom format. The concert was discreetly provided to viewers at the Center and was not available via the channels or internet.

Live Streaming Sports

Sports are back at NMTV and in a big way! Not only are we using our production truck to cover high school sports, we are also sending out single camera teams to additional sporting events for live coverage. The goal is to cover every high school sporting event, at all three high schools we cover, live. The idea of covering all of our high school sporting events resulted from the realization that in-person crowds might not be allowed, or at least would likely be restricted. Video Engineer, Matt Waldron, and Sports Director, Kenton Kipp, along with Sports Producer, Jeremy Millington, determined the



equipment and staffing that would be required to accomplish that feat and then went to work. With a minimal amount of equipment purchases and by utilizing the public internet and free software, we are able to live stream single camera games to the NMTV facility, where a director adds graphics and then sends it out live via various outlets including Facebook, YouTube, and on our streaming and cable channels. It takes a lot of work and coordination, but so far the Sports crew has been phenominal.

City Productions

In September, Municipal Producer, Trevor Scholl, completed three productions, including a Fall Mayor's Minutes with Centerville Mayor, D. Love, coverage of a Quad Area Chamber of Commerce Event, and the Cars for Neighbors Gala. In addition, he worked all month assisting Danika Peterson and Rusty Ray with Candidate forums, and also assisted T.J. Tronson with coverage of League of Women Voters sponsored forums and a private concert at the Mary Ann Young Center. Programs completed include:

Meetings are scheduled for replay based on schedules requested by each City. Additional longer-length video programming, produced by NMTV staff, is also scheduled on the channels. With the arrival of the Carousel units, shorter-length videos and promos are loaded onto those devices, rather than being scheduled as separate playbacks. The short videos cycle through, with graphics pages, and play on the channels whenever a scheduled program is not playing. Depending on whether a City selected the split screen or full screen Carousel option, the shorter videos are cycling 24 hours a day. The table below outlines how many times a longer-length video program was entered into the Tightrope system, and played back on each City channel.

The last category of programming on City channels consists of bulletin board, or graphics pages, that display information about the City or about events and issues of interest to citizens. Meetings on Demand









NMTV has created a video on demand service, with line-item bookmarking, for our Cities' meetings. In order to accomplish this, each encoded meeting has to undergo several steps. The meeting must first be transferred and transcoded from the playback server to the video on demand server. The length of time necessary for this varies based on the length of the meeting and whether it is recorded in SD or HD. Once that is done, a staff member must go through the meeting entering a bookmark at the start of each meeting line-item, and enter the corresponding line-item information. Staff utilizes marked agendas provided by City staff members for this step. If marked agendas aren't provided by City staff we go to the City website to find unmarked agendas and place the meeting on VOD without bookmarks. Once that is done and saved the bookmarked meeting is then linked to the NMTV website's city meeting page for video on demand. CITY OF LEXINGTON WORKSHOP SYNOPSIS Thursday, October 15, 2020 Immediately following Council meeting City Hall

Mayor Murphy called to order the workshop for October 15, 2020 at 7:22 p.m. Councilmember's present: Devries, Harris, Hughes, and Winge. Also Present: Bill Petracek, City Administrator; Kurt Glaser, City Attorney; Chris Galiov, Finance Director.

3. Discussion Items:

A. Discuss

• Chapter 17 – User Charge For Excessive Use of Law Enforcement Services

Mayor Murphy explained he wanted to discuss this ordinance with the City Council to ensure that the City has a strong enough regulations in place as we continue to construct large multifamily housing complexes in Lexington. He wanted to ensure that we have the ability to send any new building owner a bill if our police costs go up due to their overuse of our law enforcement. Discussion ensued.

Attorney Glaser provided a discussion on the existing ordinance — Chapter 17 — pertaining to excessive use of law enforcement. Mayor Murphy asked if we need to beef up the ordinance for the new apartments. Attorney Glaser suggested having a graduated scale of fees to be assessed for excessive use of law enforcement to ensure the multi-family apartment owners pay a higher fee for excessive use of law enforcement. Discussion ensued.

Petracek suggested that if parking violations are the highest percentage of calls at these new apartment complexes, rather than penalize the building owner, we should be increasing our parking fines. Attorney Glaser added that the current fine for parking violations is \$47 and can be increased to \$300. Discussion ensued.

Mayor Murphy asked the Council if they should have the attorney draft an amendment to Chapter 17 to incorporate bigger fines for excessive use of law enforcement by the bigger buildings in Lexington. Attorney Glaser suggested waiting until after the winter parking regulations expire for the season in April to move forward with changes. Discussion ensued.

The Council asked if the police reports could:

- 1. Report parking violations separately
- 2. Determine if the violation address is associated with the apartment complex
- 3. Report any other problem addresses in the City that are using the police excessively.

No action was taken.

Discuss Lexington Liquor Logo

The City Council reviewed the proposed new Lexington Liquor sign logo that Mayor Murphy's company drafted. Discussion ensued.

The consensus was to go with the logo on page 5 of the workshop packet.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice duly given as required by law, the council has met and heard and passed upon all objections to the proposed assessment for the 2020 Improvement project of Jackson Avenue between Restwood Road and Woodland Road by milling the surface and placing a bituminous overlay with street repairs as needed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, MINNESOTA:

- 1. Such proposed assessment, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby accepted and shall constitute the special assessment against the lands named therein, and each tract of land therein included is hereby found to be benefited by the proposed improvement in the amount of the assessment levied against it.
- 2. Such assessment shall be payable in equal annual installments extending over a period of 10 years, the first of the installments to be payable on or before the first Monday in January 2021, and shall bear interest at the rate of 3.0 percent per annum from the date of the adoption of this assessment resolution. To the first installment shall be added interest on the entire assessment from the date of this resolution until December 31, 2021. To each subsequent installment, when due, shall be added interest for one year on all unpaid installments.
- 3. The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the county auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the city treasurer, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within 30 days from the adoption of this resolution; and he/she may, at any time thereafter, pay to the city treasurer the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the next succeeding year.
- 4. The clerk shall forthwith transmit a certified duplicate of this assessment to the county auditor to be extended on the property tax lists of the county. Such assessments shall be collected and paid over in the same manner as other municipal taxes.

SUBJECT: RELEASE OF LETTER OF CREDIT

DATE: 10/26/2020

SUMMARY: Staff recommends the Council authorize the City to release all Letters of Credit governing the Ephesians project.

COUNCIL ACTION: Motion authorizing the City to release all Letters of Credit governing the Ephesians project on the condition that the City takes possession of a bond in the amount of \$90,000 to warranty public improvements constructed by the Developer.

DISCUSSION: The Ephesians project is finished. The Developer has one obligation remaining; they must provide the City with a \$90,000 bond for the purpose of warrantying the public improvements they constructed (i.e. sewers, watermains, etc.). The Developer has already provided that bond to the City.

As part of the overall development, the City required the Developer to provide security to ensure construction of all phases of the project. Since the project is finished, the City no longer needs that security. The Developer provided that security in the form of Letters of Credit from two banks. Those Letters of Credit provided security for several hundred thousand dollars. Since the warranty bond is now in place, the City no longer needs those Letters of Credit.

- B. The first immediate transfer (in its entirety, but not in part) by such legal representative to a third party after express approval of a governmental body (judicial, administrative, or executive).

TRANSFEREES REQUIRED DOCUMENTS. When the presenter is a permitted transferee (i) by operation of law or (ii) a third party receiving transfer from a legal representative, as described above, the documents required for a draw shall include a certified copy of the one or more documents which show the presenter's authority to claim through or to act with authority for the original Beneficiary.

COMPLIANCE BURDEN. Lender is not responsible for any impossibility or other difficulty in achieving strict compliance with the requirements of this Letter of Credit precisely as written. Beneficiary understands and acknowledges: (i) that unless and until the present wording of this Letter of Credit is amended with Lender's prior written consent, the burden of complying strictly with such wording remains solely upon Beneficiary, and (ii) that Lender is relying upon the lack of such amendment as constituting Beneficiary's initial and continued approval of such wording.

NON-SEVERABILITY. If any aspect of this Letter of Credit is ever declared unenforceable for any reason by any court or governmental body having jurisdiction, Lender's entire engagement under this Letter of Credit shall be deemed null and void ab initio, and both Lender and Beneficiary shall be restored to the position each would have occupied with all rights available as though this Letter of Credit had never occurred. This non-severability provision shall override all other provisions in this Letter of Credit, no matter where such provision appears within this Letter of Credit.

GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement will be governed by federal law applicable to Lender and, to the extent not preempted by federal law, the laws of the State of Minnesota without regard to its conflicts of law provisions, and except to the extent such laws are inconsistent with the 2007 Revision of the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits of the International Chamber of Commerce, ICC Publication No. 600. This Agreement has been accepted by Lender in the State of Minnesota.

EXPIRATION. Lender hereby agrees with Beneficiary that drafts drawn under and in compliance with the terms of this Letter of Credit will be duly honored if presented to Lender on or before the Expiration Date unless otherwise provided for above.
