Mayor Kurth called to order the workshop for June 20, 2019 at 7:57 p.m. Councilmember's present: Devries, Harris, Hughes, and Murphy. Also Present: Bill Petracek, City Administrator; Chris Galiov, Finance Director.

- Park Board Recommendation for Memorial Park Capital Improvements

Councilmember Devries stated he has a problem with the concession stand upgrades. He believes that Centennial Little League should be paying for all of the upgrades, since they are the only organization, and not the City of Lexington, making money off of the concession stand. Discussion ensued.

Mayor Kurth stated that he believes the City should tear down the whole concession stand instead of doing a roof and fascia replacement. The City Council discussed the Park Board recommendation.

Councilmember Devries recommended looking at a two-car garage that can be moved in as a possible replacement of the existing concession stand. He will provide more information on this type of building at budget time. Discussion ensued.

Petracek stated we will have more discussion about the Park Board recommendations at budget time, as these projects will not be completed in 2019.
