Due to the high volume of liquor sales that was generated from the pandemic conditions in 2020 and the extraordinary level of effort that was put forth by my management staff and sales clerks, I am requesting that you consider adjusting the following employees' salaries to reflect their incredible effort this past year.

Salary Recommendations:

Andy Lyons, Beer Department Supervisor - 7% increase.

Mr. Lyons has shown a great deal of dedication to our operation this past year and has worked tirelessly to ensure the smooth operation of the beer department. He also, in spite of the high customer volume, has been able to maintain a remarkable level of customer service.

Karen Larson, Supervisor - 5% increase.

Ms. Larson has done a tremendous job of keeping pace with the new product placement and maintaining the challenging scheduling issues dealing with the part-time employees during the pandemic. She is a major reason why we have been able to keep up with the demand for liquor this past year.

Part time Sales Clerks - 3 % increase

The part-time staff has performed well under the difficult circumstances in spite of some of them being reluctant to work during the pandemic and the risk of becoming infected.

Re: Management and Non Union Salary Increase Recommendation

We have conducted our annual employee reviews for full-time management and non-union employees during the month of May and June. Based on the annual reviews, I am recommending wage adjustments for the following management and non-union (liquor store) employees. These salary increases, if approved by the City Council, will go into effect retroactively to June 1, 2021.

This year the management staff of all departments – police, fire, public works, liquor store, city hall staff-have done a tremendous job of keeping the operations of city services continuous during the pandemic, in spite of several employees being infected with Covid 19. This has made it a bit challenging to keep the City functioning this past year. Nonetheless, we have prevailed without any disruptions to the services that we provide our citizens.

The liquor store staff has especially done an exceptional job of keeping operations going and increasing our gross and net revenues to a level never seen before in Lexington. Those sales numbers continue to remain much higher than the 2019 fiscal year as the pandemic slows. The liquor store was able to accomplish this in spite of being directly exposed to the public every day.

I am recommending the following salaries for management and non-union employees based on the performance of these individuals this past year.
